## NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President has signed S. 3056 -- Guatemala Relief and Rehabilitation Act of 1976. This bill authorizes fiscal year 1976 appropriations of \$25 million to the President to provide emergency relief, rehabilitation and humanitarian assistance to the people who have been victorized by the recent earthquakes in Guatemala.

## 

The President has signed H.R. 1465 -- Division of Assets, certain California Indians. This bill provides for the division of certain assets between the Twenty-nine Palms Band and the Cabazon Band of Mission Indians, California, including land and certain funds in the United States Treasury.

The bill directs the Secretary of the Interior to transfer to the Twenty-Nine Palms Band of Mission Indians from the Cabazon Band of Mission Indians the latter's beneficial interest in approximately 240 acres of land in trust along with \$2,825 plus earned interest.

The President has signed H.R. 11598 -- United States Information Agency Authorization Act, Fiscal Year 1976. This bill authorizes appropriations of \$266,777,000 for fiscal year 1976 and \$71,900,000 for the transition quarter (July 1, 1976 - September 30, 1976) for the United States Information Agency, and for other purposes.

The President has signed S.2444 -- Fiscal Year Transition Act and S. 2445 -- Fiscal Year Adjustment Act.

This bill will make necessry adjustments and technical changes in current law required as a result of the shift to the new October-September fiscal year, effective October 1, 1976.
