The President has accepted the resignation of four persons as members of the National Commission on the Observance of International Women's Year, 1975, effective today. They were appointed on April 14, 1975. They are:

Richard Cornuelle, of New York, New York

Helen K. Copley, of La Jolla, California

Winfield Dunn, of Nashville, Tennessee

The Commission consists of not more than 35 members to be appointed by the President from among citizens in private life.

The President has acknowledged the retirement of Walter Pettus Gewin, of Tuscaloosa, Alabama, as a Circuit Judge for the Fifth Circuit, effective November 1, 1976. He was appointed in 1961 and reappointed on February 9, 1962.
