NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President is gratified to learn of the decision of the United States District Court that it would be unlawful for AT&T to furnish to the Congress the highly sensitive National Security information covered by a Congressional subpoena issued to AT&T.

The Court has rendered a judgment in favor of the President's position and has enjoined AT&T permanently from supplying such information without permission of the President. This decision recognizes the right of the President to determine when there are unacceptable risks in furnishing such information to the Congress.
