NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today announced his intention to withdraw the nomination of Joseph R. Fogarty of Middletown, Rhode Island, as a member of the Federal Communications Commission for the unexpired term of seven years from July 1, 1971.

The President today also announced his intention to nominate Mr. Fogarty to be a member of the Commission for a term of seven years from July 1, 1976. He will succeed Glenn O. Robinson whose term expired on June 30, 1976.

Prior to his nomination, Mr. Fogarty was Communications Counsel for the United States Senate Committee on Commerce, beginning in 1975.

The President today announced his intention to withdraw the nomination of Margita E. White of McLean, Virginia, as a member of the Federal Communications Commission for a term of seven years from July 1, 1976.

The President today also announced his intention to nominate Mrs. White to be a member of the Commission for the unexpired term of seven years from July 1, 1971. She will succeed Charlotte R. Reid who resigned effective July 1, 1976.

Prior to her nomination, Mrs. White was Director of the Office of Communications beginning on June 18, 1975.
