POOL REPORT

San Francisco International Airport to Sutro House

October 4, 1976

Motorcade from airport to Pacific Heights neighborhood uneventful. Except for a few bystanders at bus stops, streets virtually deserted.

Mr. and Mrs. John Sutro greeted President on sidewalk in front of their home. House hidden by trees and other foliage. A red brick wall appears to surround the house although we were unable to see the rear entrance. President also greeted by Mr. and Mrs. Frank Woods and 3 children. Woods' home is being used by Presidential staff, Cheney, et al. It is next door according to Woods.

A friendly crowd cheered as motorcade drove up. Appeared to be neighborhood residents, many children.

President said he couldn't see the children because TV lights were focused at him in the darkness. He waved, went into the Sutro house.
