The President today announced the appointment of three persons as members of the National Highway Cafety Advisory Committee. They are:

The Committee consists of thirty-five members appointed by the President for terms of three years and the Secretary of Transportation, Federal Highway Administrator and the National Highway Traffic Cafety & Administrator as exofficio members.

The Committee was established by Public Law 39-554 of September 9, 1965 to provide advice and counsel to the Secretary of Transportation on Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards and other highway safety matters.
