October 13, 1976

The Chief of Police for White Plains, J. Stewart Henry, estimated the crowd at White Plains between 4,000 and 5,000. But local advanceman Spencer Knapp then produced Deputy Commission of Public Safety, Carmine Motto, who said the crowd was over 15,000.

The pool asked Nessen Ford's reaction to the swine flu deaths, and Nessen had no reaction from Ford, but said that the President would get his swine flu shot tomorrow morning.
