DEFINITIONS

Amcoach: Regular coach car with 84 seats.

Amcafe: 56 seats plus food service unit providing hot and cold

food and beverages.

Amdinette: 36 seats, food service unit and 8 tables.

Amclub: 18 first class and 28 coach seats, plus food service unit.
