NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President has accepted the resignation of Earl Sidney Willis, of Greenwich, Connecticut, as a member of the Advisory Committee to the Pension Benefit Guaranty Corporation effective November 30, 1976. He was appointed on February 20, 1975 for a term which was to expire February 19, 1977.

There is no successor to announce at this time.

The President today accepted the resignation of James L. Palmer, of Burlington, Wisconsin, as a member of the Board of Directors of the Federal Prison Industries, Incorporated, effective November 10, 1976. He was appointed on September 11, 1951.

There is no successor to announce at this time.

The President has accepted the resignation of Donald E. Walter, of Shreveport, Louisiana, as United States Attorney for the Western District of Louisiana, effective upon the appointment and qualification of a successor. He was appointed on July 14, 1969 and was reappointed on December 19, 1973.

The President has accepted the resignation of James F. Companion, of Wheeling, West Virginia, as United States Attorney for the Northern District of West Virginia, effective December 31, 1976. He was appointed for a term of four years on April 17, 1973.
