QUESTION: Can you tell us anything about the meeting?

SECRETARY CALLAGHAN: Frank, friendly and constructive.

SECRETARY KISSINGER: We really reviewed the world situation and the Middle East, energy, Cyprus, some odds and ends of the NATO meeting and I would say this: it would seem to me complete agreement and a very friendly atmosphere.

QUESTION: Do you expect anything in the way of important developments on Cyprus today?

SECRETARY KISSINGER: No, not today.

QUESTION: Tomorrow?

SECRETARY KISSINGER: Not tomorrow, either.
