UPON DEPARTURE FROM BONN
FEBRUARY 16, 1975

We have concluded two very satisfying sessions with both the Foreign Minister and the Chancellor. The visit was conducted in an extremely cordial atmosphere, and there was a complete identity of views on all of the subjects discussed. As far as we are concerned, I can say the relations between the Federal Republic and the United States have never been better, and I want to thank the Chancellor and the Foreign Minister for receiving us so cordially and for exchanging views so frankly.
