NATIONAL MOBILE HOME ADVISORY COUNCIL May 5, 1975

THE NATIONAL MOBILE HOME CONSTRUCTION AND SAFETY
STANDARDS ACT WHICH PASSED LAST AUGUST REQUIRES THAT HUD

HOMES SOLD IN THIS COUNTRY. CONGRESS APPROVED THE PROCEDURE
