PLEASE PASS FOLLOWING FROM ME TO FOREIGN MINISTER ESENBEL:

BEGIN TEXT DEAR MR. MINISTER:

I AM ENCOURAGED BY AMBASSADOR MACOMBER'S REPORT ON HIS CONVERSATION WITH YOU AND YOUR EVIDENT DESIRE TO MOVE AHEAD RAPIDLY TOWARD SUBSTANTIVE NEGOTIATIONS ON CYPRUS. I UNDERSTAND THEREFORE YOUR SUGGESTION THAT I VISIT ANKARA AT END OF MY CURRENT TRIP AND I AM GRATEFUL FOR THE INVITATION.

IT SEEMS TO ME, HOWEVER, THAT BEFORE ANY FIRM DECISION CAN BE MADE ON WHETHER I SHOULD INCLUDE AN ANKARA STOP ON MY WAY BACK TO THE UNITED STATES, I WILL BE NECESSARY TO DETERMINE, WITH SOME PRECISION, SEVERAL THINGS.

FIRST, I WILL NEED TO GET IN TOUCH WITH THE NEW GREEK GOVERNMENT TO GET SOME FEEL FOR HOW PRIME MINISTER CARAMANLIS AND HIS FOREIGN MINISTER VIEW THE FUTURE OF THE CYPRUS ISSUE AND WHAT THEIR REACTION WOULD NOW BE TO TURKISH MOVES, AS CONTEMPLATED, ESPECIALLY WHETHER IT WOULD TRIGGER POLITICAL TALK.



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SECONDLY, I AM CONVINCED THAT A VISIT TO ANKARA NOW WITHOUT SOME ASSURANCE OF SUBSTANTIVE RESULTS WOULD BE COUNTERPRODUCTIVE TO THE WHOLE FUTURE COURSE OF THE CYPRUS NEGOTIATIONS AND DISASTROUS IN TERMS OF THE ARRITUDES OF OUR OWN CONGRESS. AS YOU ARE WELL AWARE, OUR CONGRESS HAS ALREADY PROVED EXTREMELY DIFEICULT WHERE CYPRUS IS CONCERNED; THIS IS LIKELY TO BE EVEN MORE THE CASE NOW THAT CONGRESS IS CONSIDERING THE FOREIGN AID BILL IN ITS CLOSING DAYS

THESE PROBLEMS WOULD BE HEIGHTENED BY THE EXPECTATIONS THAT WOULD INEVITABLY BE CREATED BY THE EXTRAORDINARY NATURE OF A TRIP WHICH WOULD TAKE ME FROM CHINA TO ANKARA RATHER THAN THE RETURN TO WASHINGTON EVERYONE NOW EXPECTS.

FOR THESE REASONS, AND IN ORDER TO MAKE IT POSSIBLE TO MAKE A DECISION ON WHETHER A VISIT TO ANKARA NOW WOULD BE WISE, I URGENTLY NEED AS CLEAR A STATEMENT AS POSSIBLE FROM YOU OF THE GESTURES YOU THINK THE GOVERNMENT OF TURKEY MIGHT BE PREPARED TO ANNOUNCE AT THE CLOSE OF MY VISIT. I ASK THIS NOT IN ORDER TO INITIATE A BARGAINING PHASE BUT RATHER BECAUSE OF MY CONCERN THAT SOME SUBSTANTIVE PROGRESS BE DEMONSTRATED AS DERIVING FROM MY VISIT TO ANKARA.

IN ANY EVENT, AS I AM SURE YOU REALIZE, TO ADD ANKARA TO MY ITINERARY NOW WOULD BE EXTREMELY DIFFICULT. AS I LOOK AT MY SCHEDULE IT SEEMS TO ME THAT THE ONLY TIME THAT MIGHT POSSIBLY WORK WOULD BE AN ARRIVAL LATE IN THE DAY OF NOVEMBER 30, WITH MEETINGS TO FOLLOW ON DECEMBER 1 AND DEPARTURE TO PERMIT ARRIVAL IN WASHINGTON LATE ON DEC 1. UNFORTUNATELY, IT WILL NOT BE POSSIBLE FOR ME TO COME TO ANKARA PRIOR TO THE NATO MINISTERIAL MEETING BECAUSE OF THE SCHEDULED VISIT OF A FOREIGN MINISTER TO WASHINGTON ON THE DAYS IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING MY DEPARTURE FOR BRUSSELS. IT MAY BE, THEREFORE, THAT WE WILL HAVE TO DELAY OUR TALKS UNTIL WE SEE EACH OTHER AT THE NATO MEETING.

I LOOK FORWARD TO WORKING CLOSELY WITH YOU, MR. MINISTER, WHETHER A VISIT TO ANKARA NOW IS POSSIBLE OR WISE OR NOT. I AM SURE THAT YOU WILL UNDERSTAND THE REASONS FOR MY CAUTION, AND LOOK FORWARD TO A FRANK RESPONSE TO THE CONSIDERATIONS I HAVE RAISED.

WHEN YOU PRESENT TO FOREIGN MINISTER BITSIOS MY ORAL MESSAGE CONTAINED SECTO 82, YOU SHOULD ASK WHETHER, SHOULD I STOP IN TURKEY ON MY WAY BACK TO THE UNITED STATES, THE GREEK GOVERNMENT WOULD BE PREPARED TO PROCEED ON THE BASIS OF THE SCENARIO I HAVE ALREADY DISCUSSED WITH FOREIGN MINISTER BITSIOS. THAT IS, WOULD THE GREEK GOVERNMENT BE PREPARED TO MOVE THE CLERIDES-DENKTASH TALKS TO A POLITICAL LEVEL IN RETURN FOR SOME UNILATERAL TURKISH CONCESSIONS.

2. YOU SHOULD ALSO INDICATE TO BITSIOS THAT MY OWN PERSONAL PREFERENCE WOULD BE FOR DISCUSSIONS ON DECEMBER 10 OR 11 IN BRUSSELS, RATHER THAN A STOP IN ANKARA ON THE WAY BACK FROM THIS TRIP.

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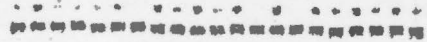

1. YOU WILL HAVE SEEN AMBASSADOR GODLEY'S MESSAGE PROPOSING THAT HE RETURN TO WASHINGTON ON CONSULTATIONS MORNING NOVEMBER 22 (BEIRUT 14027). WHEN I FIRST RECEIVED GODLEY'S CABLE I WAS NOT INCLINED TO GO ALONG WITH THIS IDEA AND WAS CONSIDERING PROPOSING A LETTER FROM YOU TO PRESIDENT FRANGIE WHICH WE HOPED MIGHT SMOOTH THINGS OVER AND MAKE IT POSSIBLE FOR GODLEY TO ATTEND FRANGIE'S NATIONAL DAY RECEPTION ON NOVEMBER 22. SINCE THEN HOWEVER FOREIGN MINISTER TAQLA HAS INFORMALLY CONVEYED TO US THROUGH LEBANESE AMBASSADOR HERE REQUEST THAT WE BRING BACK GODLEY IN ORDER TO GIVE HIM MORE TIME TO TRY TO COOL FRANGIE DOWN.
 2. SINCE THIS IS TAQLA'S REQUEST, AND WE KNOW HE IS A FRIEND AND IS TRYING TO BE HELPFUL, I BELIEVE BEST SOLUTION IS TO RECALL GODLEY ON CONSULTATIONS. REGRETTABLY MUST ASK FOR YOUR IMMEDIATE REACTION TO THIS SINCE WE WOULD WANT TO HAVE GODLEY LEAVE BEIRUT EARLY MORNING NOVEMBER 22 SO THAT HE WOULD NOT BE IN COUNTRY AT TIME OF FRANGIE'S RECEPTION.
 3. WOULD PROPOSE THAT IF ASKED WE LIMIT OURSELVES TO TELLING PRESS THAT GODLEY IS BEING RECALLED ON CONSULTATIONS, WITHOUT ELABORATING. INGERSOLL
