1. WE HAVE RAISED WITH GOJ QUESTION OF ITS INTENTIONS RE ACTIVE SUPPORT OF FRIENDLY KOREAN ITEM IN THIS YEAR'S UNGA AT EVERY APPROPRIATE OPPORTUNITY AS JAPANESE-KOREAN DIFFICULTIES HAVE EVOLVED. ANSWER EACH TIME HAS BEEN CLEAR-CUT STATEMENT OF INTENTION TO CONTINUE SAME POLICY AS BEFORE; SPECIFICALLY, GOJ INTENDS TO CONTINUE ACTIVE COLLABORATION WITH US AND OTHER FRIENDLY DELEGATIONS IN NEW YORK. MOST RECENT STATEMENT WAS THAT BY FOMIN KIMURA TO AMBASSADOR HODGSON SEPT 7 (TOKYO 11599) THAT GOJ POLICY TOWARD KOREA HAS NOT CHANGED IN ANY REGARD, DESPITE RECENT INTENSIFICATION OF DIFFICULTIES.

2. GOJ OBVIOUSLY, HOWEVER, WILL BE FACED WITH NEW SITUATION IF RELATIONS CONTINUE TO DETERIORATE, PARTICULARLY TO POINT OF RUPTURE OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS. PRESSURE ON TANAKA GOVERNMENT FROM OPPOSITION AND SIGNIFICANT ELEMENTS OF CONSERVATIVE PARTY WOULD DEMAND SOME CHANGE IN GOJ SUPPORT FOR ROK IN UN AND ELSEWHERE. ONE CIRCUMSTANCE FREQUENTLY CITED PUBLICLY WHERE CHANGE MAY OCCUR RE FUTURE JAPAN POLICY TOWARD ROK IS THE MATTER OF CONTINUITY AND AMOUNT OF FUTURE JAPANESE AID TO ROK. THIS WOULD LEAD TO CONCLUSION THAT OTHER POLICY CHANGES MAY NECESSARILY ENSUE IF CURRENT RELATIONS SITUATION IS NOT RESOLVED.

3. WE INTEND TO CONTINUE TO PROBE JAPANESE INTENTIONS ON ENTIRE RANGE OF POLICY PROBLEMS PRESENTED TO GOJ IN CURRENT CONFLICT WITH ROK AS POSSIBLE AND APPROPRIATE. WE WOULD ASSUME, HOWEVER, THAT GOJ RESPONSE FOR THE MOMENT WOULD BE VERY CLOSE TO BLANKET REAFFIRMATION OF UNCHANGED POSITION GIVEN US THIS WEEKEND BY FOREIGN MINISTER, WITH

PERHAPS INCREASED INDICATIONS OF POSSIBILITY OF CHANGES IF SITUATION DEVELOPS ADVERSELY. NEXT BENCH-MARK FOR THIS KIND OF DECISION MAY VERY LIKELY BE AFTER DELIVERY OF TANAKA LETTER AND READING OF ROKG REACTIONS. IF THINGS GO BADLY, WE WOULD NOT BE SURPRISED IF GOJ EFFORTS IN NEW YORK FALL OFF, THOUGH PROBABLY WITHOUT ANY PUBLIC STATEMENT OR FORMAL CHANGE OF POSITION.

4. WE WILL BE REPORTING FULLY AS INFORMATION AND IMPRESSIONS BECOME AVAILABLE.

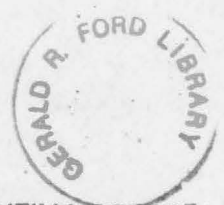

1. ONE WEEK AFTER YOUR VISIT TO TOKYO, WE ARE PLEASED TO REPORT THERE HAS BEEN NO PUBLIC LEAK OF TEXT OR MAIN CONTENTS OF REFTEL PAPER GIVEN TO FOREIGN OFFICE AND MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

2. YOUR VISIT RECEIVED ONLY MODEST PRESS COVERAGE DUE TO DOMESTIC PREOCCUPATION WITH PM'S POLITICAL PROBLEMS AND UPCOMING VISIT OF PRESIDENT FORD. ARTICLES ON INSIDE PAGES NOVEMBER 7 ISSUES OF ASAHI MAINICHI AND SANKEI HAD DIFFERENT ACCOUNTS OF WHAT YOU AND COOPER SAID TO GOJ OFFICIALS. SANKEI INDICATED EMPHASIS WAS ON ENERGY CONSERVATION WITH US PRESENTING (AND GOJ LISTENING TO) US IDEAS ON FOLLOW-UP TO BIG-5 MEETING, OIL-DOLLAR RECYCLING, AND PRODUCER-CONSUMER CONFERENCE. MAINICHI INDICATED GISCARD INITIATIVE WAS DISCUSSED WITH NEITHER US NOR GOJ READY TO TAKE STAND ON IT. ARTICLE SAID US DID NOT DIRECTLY TAKE UP QUESTION OF BIG-5 FOLLOW-UP NOR DID US SIDE MAKE ANY REQUESTS OF JAPAN. 1. PLEASE PASS MESSAGE BELOW FROM ME TO KING HUSSEIN.

YOUR MAJESTY:

I SHARE THE CONCERN WHICH YOU EXPRESSED TO AMBASSADOR PICKERING OVER THE EVENTS OF THE PAST SEVERAL DAYS, AND I WANT YOU TO HAVE MY PERSONAL ACCOUNT OF STEPS WE HAVE TAKEN TO HELP REDUCE TENSION. AS YOUR MAJESTY WELL KNOWS, WE ARE KEENLY AWARE OF THE SERIOUS CONSEQUENCES A RENEWAL OF FIGHTING WOULD HAVE, BOTH FOR THE PEOPLE OF THE MIDDLE EAST AND FOR AMERICAN INTERESTS THERE. ANOTHER WAR WOULD JEOPARDIZE EVERYTHING THAT HAS BEEN ACHIEVED OVER THE PAST YEAR IN THE CAUSE OF

PEACE WITH SO MUCH COURAGE AND WISDOM ON ALL SIDES. LAST FIRDAY MORNING WE RECEIVED WORD FROM THE ISRAELIS THAT, IN RESPONSE TO AN "ACCUMULATIONS OF INFORMATION" ABOUT SYRIAN MILITARY PREPARATIONS, ISRAEL WAS CALLING TO ACTIVE DUTY

A FEW THOUSAND RESERVISTS. AT THE SAME TIME, ISRAEL STATED THAT IT INTENDED FULLY TO CONTINUE ITS OBSERVANCE OF THE DISENGAGEMENT AGREEMENT AND THAT ITS MOVES WERE PRECAUTIONARY AND DEFENSIVE. I COMMUNICATED IMMEDIATELY WITH PRESIDENT ASAD, INFORMING HIM OF THE ISRAELI STATEMENTS. MY PURPOSE WAS TO ASSURE FULL UNDERSTANDING ON EACH SIDE OF THE OTHER'S MOVES AND STATED PURPOSES. I HAD A VERY PROMPT AND WARM RESPONSE FROM PRESIDENT ASAD TO THE EFFECT THAT SYRIA DID NOT INTEND TO INITIATE MILITARY ACTION, ESPECIALLY AT THIS TIME WHEN THERE IS HOPE OF NEW DIPLOMATIC PROGRESS.

WHEN I INFORMED THE ISRAELI GOVERNMENT OF PRESIDENT ASAD'S MESSAGE THE ISRAELIS REPEATED THAT THEY HAD NO INTENTION OF INITIATING MILITARY ACTION. THE ISRAELI AMBASSADOR SAID THIS PUBLICLY AT THE STATE DEPARTMENT AFTER MEETING WITH ME, AND SINCE THAT TIME THERE SEEMS TO HAVE BEEN SOME REDUCTION OF TENSION, AT LEAST IN THE PUBLIC HANDLING OF THE SITUATION.

AS YOUR MAJESTY KNOWS, HOWEVER, BOTH SIDES REMAIN IN A HIGH STATE MILITARY READINESS, AND THE RESUMPTION OF HOSTILITIES BY MISCALUCATION CANNOT AT ALL BE RULED OUT. REGRETTABLY, THE COMING PERIOD OF DEBATE OVER WHETHER THE MANDATE OF THE UNDOF SHOULD BE RENEWED WILL CONTRIBUTE TO KEEPING TENSION AT A LEVEL ABOVE THAT OF LAST WEEK. THAT FOREIGN MINISTER KHADDAM HAD TOLD SECRETARY GENERAL WALDHEIM THAT SYRIA WOULD NOT AGREE TO EXTENSION OF THE UNDOF MANDATE, I WROTE TO PRESIDENT ASAD POINTING OUT THAT SYRIA'S REFUSAL TO AGREE TO UNDOF'S CONTINUED OPERATION WOULD BE READ IN ISRAEL AS AN ABROGATION OF THE DISENGAGEMENT AGREEMENT. IT HAS BEEN SUGGESTED THAT SYRIA WOULD AGREE TO THE PRESENCE OF 100 UN OBSERVERS. THIS WAS PROPOSED AT THE BEGINNING OF THE DISENGAGEMENT NEGOTIATIONS LAST MAY AND WAS REJECTED BY ISRAEL. THE

NEGOTIATIONS PRODUCED AGREEMENT BY BOTH SIDES TO THE UNDOF IN ITS PRESENT SIZE AND UNDER ITS PRESENT MANDATE. THE PROTOCOL RECORDING THAT AGREEMENT IS PART OF THE DISENGAGEMENT AGREEMENT.

I WANT YOU TO KNOW THAT I HAVE INVITED FOREIGN MINISTER ALLON TO COME TO WASHINGTON THE FIRST WEEK IN DECEMBER AS SOON AS I HAVE RETURNED FROM CHINA. A FAILURE TO RENEW THE UNDOF

MANDATE WOULD GIVE THE ISRAELIS AN EXCUSE FOR NOT MOVING FURTHER IN THE NEGOTIATIONS AND WOULD HELP THOSE ELEMENTS OF AMERICAN PUBLIC OPINION WHO ARE INTENT ON DISCREDITING THOSE OF US WHO ARE TRYING TO ADVANCE THE CAUSE OF PEACE IN THE MIDDLE EAST.

I WANTED TO ASSURE YOU MAJESTTY'S ACCURATE UNDERSTANDING OF THE STEPS WE HAVE TAKEN TO HELP MAINTAIN STABILITY SO THAT, IN YOUR OWN CONSULTATIONS WITH OTHER ARAB LEADERS, YOU WILL KNOW HOW WE SEE THE ISSUES BEFORE US AND WHAT WE ARE TRYING TO ACHIEVE.
