SUBJECT:

State Dinners

Although I am still not clear on how the system is to operate for State Dinners, I wanted to pass on to you guidance received today by General Haig from the President.

- I. First, the President wants to see "new" faces at State Dinners. This includes Counsellors, White House Staff, Cabinet, etc., and the only exceptions are Secretary Kissinger and General Scowcroft--and Cabinet or Staff who have a substantive reason for being invited.
- 2. Second, a central location is needed to put together the final list for the President's approval. General Haig suggested that the office of the Staff Secretary, but is open to suggestions. In addition to compiling the final list, card files would be kept to insure fair treatment and complete coverage.
 - 3. Third, the President in line with the new guidelines amended the list for the Leone Dinner as follows:
