Reservations are not required. Visitors should come to the East Gate of the White House, located on East Executive Ave. Each guest will receive a brochure to serve as a guide to the White House grounds.

Visitors will also be able to view portions of the White House. The East Room, Green Room, Blue Room, Red Room and State Dining Room will be included on the tour.

Bands representing various branches of the Armed Services will play from the balcony outside the Blue Room throughout the tour.
