The Women Stockbrokers Association is the first and only professional organization for women who are fully registered with the New York Stock Exchange and who are associated with a New York Stock Exchange Member Firm. There are less than 200 in the United States.

The group was founded in 1964. It's purposes are to "meet and exchange ideas, to strive for improvement of standards of professionalism in the brokerage community, to enhance the image of the woman broker, and to inform the investing public that women are qualified by the New York Stock Exchange to advise on investments."

About 20 women will take part in the meeting with Mrs. Ford.
