## **Summary Description**

The James D. Haldaman audiovisual series consists primarily of 35mm and 70mm color negatives of photographs taken by Mr. Haldaman in his capacity as Senior Photographer for the Historical Committee for the Gerald R. Ford Museum Dedication Week. They depict the dedication of the Ford Presidential Museum as well as events held during the corresponding “Celebration on the Grand” in Grand Rapids, Michigan, on September 14-19, 1981. Events include the Grand Rapids trout and salmon contest; Gerald R. Ford Stamp Collection viewing and auction; Ford Museum Presidential Parade; Bob Hope television special; and fireworks displays.

The collection came with 48 contact sheets; the Ford Library created two additional contact sheets for pages of negatives that did not already have them. Mr. Haldaman organized and numbered the contact sheets. He also numbered the photos as they appeared on each contact sheet. These photo numbers do not match the frame numbers on the film, and sometimes poor quality images were not numbered at all. The Library retained Mr. Haldaman’s numbering system.

For descriptive purposes, the name Gerald R. Ford has been abbreviated to “GRF.”
