### **Summary Description**

The Arthur F. Burns audiovisual material consists of photographs and audio tapes sent to Arthur Burns while he was chairman of the Federal Reserve Board. Among the photographs, which date from 1969 to 1980, are official White House photos from the Nixon and Ford administrations, along with official Federal Reserve Board photos and those which document public appearances by Burns at various functions. The audio tapes are off-the-air copies of 1971 appearances by Dr. Burns on the network news programs "Face the Nation," "Issues and Answers," and "Meet the Press." The photographs and tapes were transferred unarranged to the Ford Library, and have been arranged chronologically.
